
# PROGRAM

## DAY 01 VILNIUS

Arrival in Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania.

### VILNIUS SIGHTSEEING & TRAKAI TOUR, 5H

In the morning, Vilnius sightseeing tour including visits to the medieval as well as the modern sections of the city. Visit the Grand Cathedral of Peter & Paul, the small church of St. Anna, a gem of Gothic architecture, and the University of Vilnius.

Departure to Trakai the medieval capital of Lithuania. On the beautifully situated island in the middle of the Galves lake, there lies a 14th century red brick castle which now houses a history museum.

After breakfast, departure to Riga. En route, a visit to the Hill of Crosses, a famous hill with more than a thousand crosses, and afterwards the splendid 18th century Rundale Palace, the former summer residence of the Duke of Kurland.

### RIGA SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, Riga city tour. The old town will delight you with the colourfully restored merchant's residences, the cozy beer cellars and cafes, historical monuments like the Dome Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, the Powder Tower and more.

View the masterpieces of early 20th century: the Art Nouveau architecture.

### 09:00      DEPARTURE FROM RIGA



View the Baltic Sea coast along the way and enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Estonian town Parnu.

See a submarine called Lembit located inside the museum, and a century-old icebreaker Suur Tõll. Experience exciting activities at the museum.

## PROPOSED 3\* HOTELS

### Panorama 3\* / Vilnius

This Hotel is situated in the Old Town of Vilnius next to the Gates of Dawn, the Town Hall Square, the Lithuanian National Philharmonic Society, and the main Old Town streets. It has 224 rooms and you can view an impressive panorama of the Old Town and skyscrapers of Vilnius through the hotel windows.



### Hotel Rixwell Elefant 3+\* / Riga

Rixwell Elefant Hotel in Riga is a modern hotel with 163 allergy-friendly rooms, centrally located between the airport (5 minutes away) and the city center near the Spice shopping mall. It offers comfortable amenities including a minibar, tea/coffee service, fitness room, spa, and restaurant with breakfast buffet and kid-friendly cuisine



### Hestia Seaport 3\* / Tallinn

Hestia Hotel Seaport is a modern three-star hotel located right next to the D-terminal of the Port of Tallinn, just about a 10-minute walk from the Old Town and city centre. It offers 109 comfortably furnished, allergy-friendly rooms with eco-friendly cork floors and air conditioning, making it suitable for both business and leisure stays.

### Best Western 4\* / Vilnius

The Best Western Vilnius is a modern 4-star hotel in the heart of Vilnius, just minutes from the Old Town. It offers 114 spacious rooms, alongside amenities like a fitness center, sauna, indoor pool, and conference spaces. Hotel has the elegant Europe Classic restaurant with European cuisine, concierge service and 24-hour reception.




### AC by Marriott Riga 4\* / Riga

### Park Inn by Radisson Meriton 4\* / Tallinn

This is a modern 4-star property in Tallinn's city center, just steps from the Old Town, Toompea Castle, and the train station. It features 465 stylish rooms (including superior, suites, and family options), an indoor pool, full-service spa with saunas and hot tubs, fitness center, and multiple dining venues like a grill restaurant, tapas bar, and café—all with free Wi-Fi and buffet breakfast included.

### I Payment Terms for Group Bookings:

A deposit of 70% of the total price for each group is due 3 months before the start of the trip.

The remaining balance is due 10 days before the start of the trip.

### II Cancellation Policy for Group Bookings

Unless otherwise agreed:

Cancellations made up to 45 days before the start of the trip are possible without any fee.

From 45 to 35 days before the start, a cancellation fee of 70% of the first night's accommodation will apply per person if more than 3 people cancel, applicable to each hotel on the booked route.

From 35 to 15 days before the start, a cancellation fee of 80% of the total package price applies for each booked person.

From 15 days to 1 day before departure (excluding weekends and official holidays in the destination country), a cancellation fee of 100% of the total package price applies for each booked person.

On the day of arrival or if the group does not show up, all booked services must be paid in full.

For certain hotels, different cancellation conditions may apply, which require prior written agreement.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

All clients are invited to bring on the trip their own refillable and reusable water bottle, to avoid as much as possible all plastic packaging.

Clients will be provided with an interactive map on where to refill the bottles during their free time.

During program tours, clients will have access to water to fill their water bottles.
