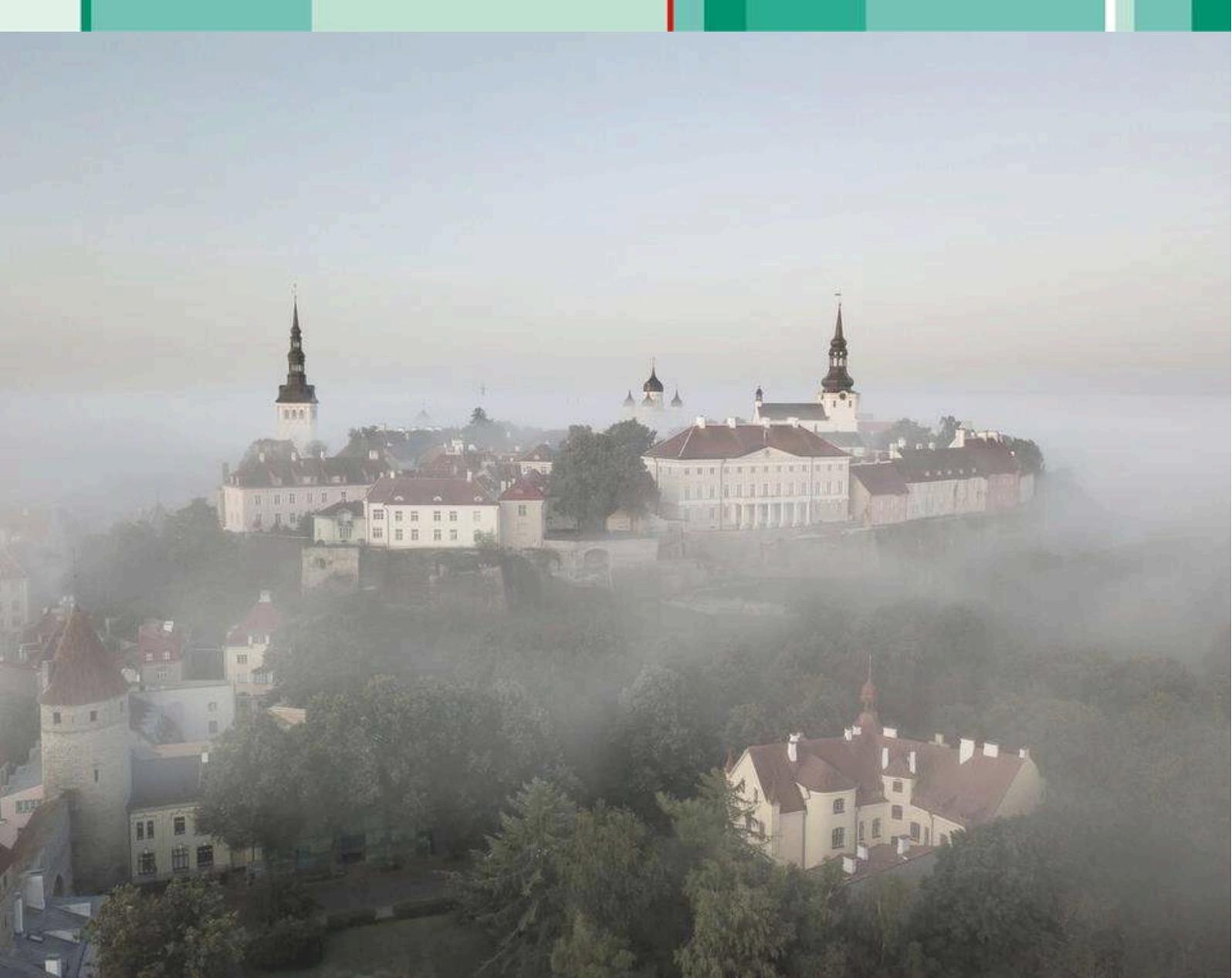

PROGRAM

DAY 01 VILNIUS

Arrival in Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania.

Optional transfer to your hotel.

Check-in at the hotel.

Welcome meeting with the tour guide at hotel Lobby bar.



DAY 02 VILNIUS

Breakfast at the hotel.

09 : 00 - 12 : 00 VILNIUS SIGHTSEEING

In the morning, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vilnius, including visits to both the medieval and modern sections of the city. Visit the Grand Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul, the small Church of St. Anne - a gem of Gothic architecture - and the University of Vilnius.

13 : 30 - 17 : 30 OPTIONAL : TRAKAI

In the afternoon, take an optional 4-hour tour to Trakai, the medieval capital of Lithuania. On a beautifully situated island in the middle of Lake Galvė stands a 14th-century red brick castle, which now houses a history museum. Evening at leisure.

DAY 03 VILNIUS - RIGA

Breakfast at the hotel & check-out

09 : 00 DEPARTURE FROM VILNIUS

After breakfast, depart by deluxe coach for Riga. En route, visit the Hill of Crosses - a famous site adorned with thousands of crosses - and the splendid 18th-century Rundāle Palace, the former summer residence of the Duke of Courland.

Lunch will be served on the way to Riga.

Upon arrival in Riga, check in at the hotel.



DAY 04 RIGA

Breakfast at the hotel.

09 : 00 - 12 : 00 RIGA SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Riga. The Old Town will delight you with its beautifully restored merchants' residences, cozy beer cellars and cafés, and historical monuments such as the Dome Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, the Powder Tower, and more.

Admire the masterpieces of early 20th-century Art Nouveau architecture.

Afternoon at leisure.

DAY 05 OPTIONAL - SIGULDA


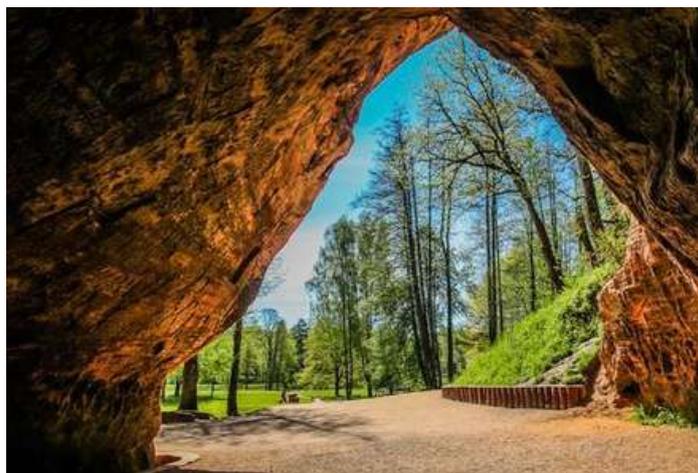
Breakfast at the hotel.

09:00 – Departure from Riga.

Optional: 5-hour sightseeing tour of Sigulda.

Sigulda is often called the “Latvian Switzerland” because of the beauty of its landscape. Visit the 13th-century Turaida Castle and the mysterious Gutmanis Cave, which is linked to a romantic medieval love legend.

Afternoon at leisure.



DAY 06 RIGA - TALLINN

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

09:00 – Departure from Riga.

After breakfast, depart by coach for Tallinn.

En route, visit the Ethnographic Open-Air Museum on the outskirts of Riga to see traditional Latvian rural buildings, some of which date back to the 17th century.

Enjoy views of the Baltic Sea coast along the way and a sightseeing tour of the Estonian town of Pärnu. Lunch will be served en route.

Upon arrival in Tallinn, check in at the hotel.

DAY 07 TALLINN

Breakfast at the hotel.

09 : 00 - 12 : 00 TALLINN CITY TOUR

After breakfast, enjoy a Tallinn city tour of the medieval Old Town.

14 : 00 - 17 : 00 OPTIONAL - KADRIORG PARK & PALACE TOUR

In the afternoon, enjoy an optional 3-hour tour to Kadriorg Park and Palace, founded in 1721 by Russian Emperor Peter the Great as a gift to his wife, Catherine I, to serve as their summer residence.



DAY 08 TALLINN

Breakfast at the hotel & check-out Departure from Tallinn.

Optional transfer to airport.

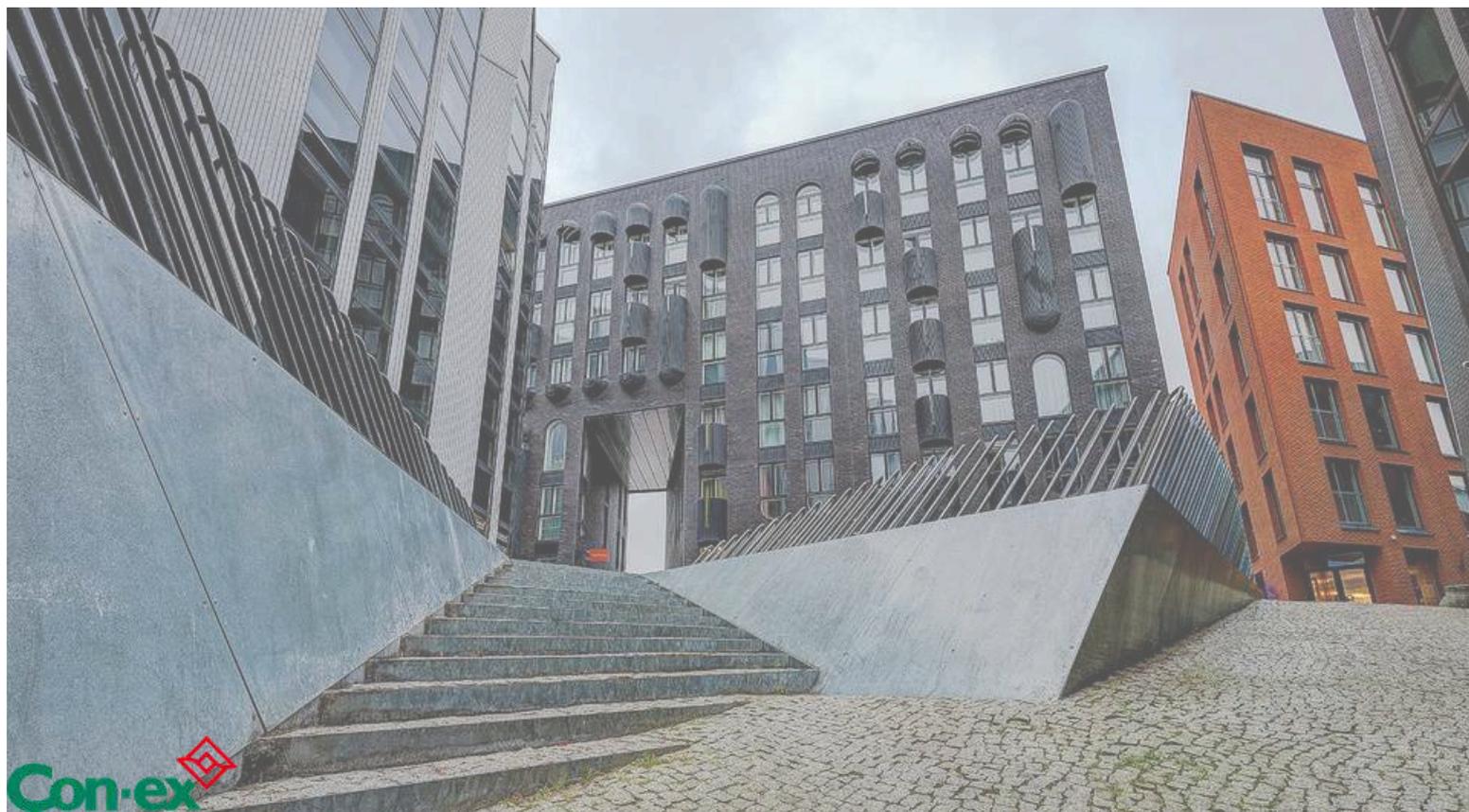

PROPOSED 3 * HOTELS


Panorama 3* / Vilnius

This Hotel is situated in the Old Town of Vilnius next to the Gates of Dawn, the Town Hall Square, the Lithuanian National Philharmonic Society, and the main Old Town streets. It has 224 rooms and you can view an impressive panorama of the Old Town and skyscrapers of Vilnius through the hotel windows.



Hotel Ibis Centre 3* / Riga

This is a vibrant hotel that has recently been refurbished into one of the outstanding midscale hotels in the centre of Riga, 90 meters from Central Station. A hotel used to be here ever since it was built in 1895 by Karl Johan Felsko. The inspiring design, bedding concept for extraordinary comfort and the charming round the clock lounge area represent the new concept of the ibis brand.



Three Crowns Residents 3* / Tallinn

Three Crowns Residence is located in one of the main streets of the Old Town some 200 meters off the City Hall Square. Close by the hotel there are plenty of restaurants, bars, cafes, museums and historic buildings that all contribute to making the place an ideal choice for your stay.

Ratonda Centrum 4* / Vilnius

Minimum number of pax for the tour: 20
